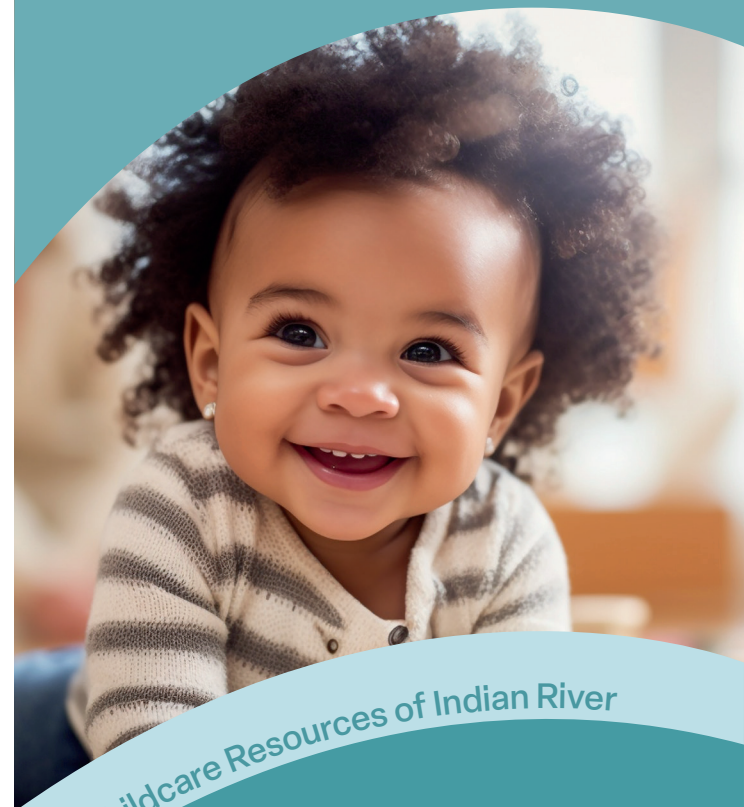
To elevate and promote the highest quality early childhood development and education in Indian River County, focusing on economically challenged children and families.

Childcare Resources works to provide wellness services to program students and their families. Wellness services include:

DEVELOPMENTAL ASSESSMENTS

All program students are screened a minimum of twice each year. These screenings help ensure children are on track to meet developmental and social emotional milestones.

HEARING & VISION SCREENINGS

All program students have the opportunity to receive basic hearing and vision screenings each year.

IN-CLASSROOM ACTIVITIES

Activities in each classroom support social-emotional competency, developmental milestones, and resiliency.

WHAT WE OFFER

BEHAVIORAL SUPPORT

Our Mental Health & Behavioral Coach offers support in the classroom setting, as well as individual intervention for children who may struggle with self-regulation or other issues within the classroom environment. A home visiting component is also available for this service which is available to all program families.

ON-SITE THERAPY

Occupational therapy, physical therapy, and speech therapy are available on-site in state-of-the-art therapy rooms. Childcare Resources works with local therapists to provide the services each student needs.

PARENT ENGAGEMENT

Family educational opportunities are offered to enable parents to explore topics such as transitioning to kindergarten, Conscious Discipline curriculum, and developmental milestones.

PARENT CAFÉS

In a Parent Café, parents have the opportunity to network with peers about parenting topics in a guided learning environment.

MENTAL HEALTH REFERRALS

Mental health referrals are available for enrolled students and program families, including siblings, parents, or guardians.

CONNECTING FAMILIES TO THE RESOURCES THEY NEED THROUGH OUR FAMILY SUPPORT SPECIALISTS
