Childcare Resources works to provide wellness services to program students and their families. Wellness services include:

- **Developmental Assessments**
All program students are screened a minimum of twice each year. These screenings help ensure children are on track to meet developmental and social-emotional milestones.
- **Hearing & Vision Screenings**
All program students have the opportunity to receive basic hearing and vision screenings each year.
- **In-Classroom Activities**
Activities in each classroom support social-emotional competency, developmental milestones, and resiliency.
- **On-Site Therapy**
Occupational therapy, physical therapy, and speech therapy are available on-site in state-of-the-art therapy rooms. Childcare Resources works with local therapists to provide the services each student needs.

- **Family Educational Opportunities**
Evening educational opportunities enable parents to explore topics like transitioning to kindergarten or the Conscious Discipline curriculum.
- **Parent Cafés**
In a Parent Café, parents have the opportunity to talk with peers about parenting topics in a guided learning environment.
- **Mental Health Referrals**
Mental health referrals are available for enrolled students and program families, including siblings, parents, or guardians.
- **Connecting Families to the Resources They Need**
Childcare Resources is a hub for early education in Indian River County. Collaborating with other local nonprofits and organizations, we help connect families to the resources they need outside of our program services.
