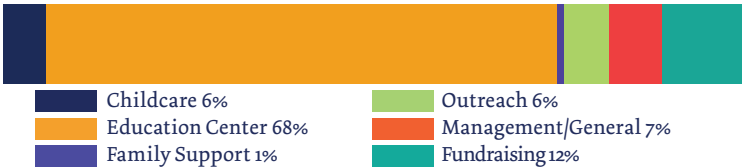
FINANCIAL SUMMARY



2024-2025 Educator Outreach Impacts:

At Childcare Resources, we believe strong teachers build strong futures. Thanks to your support, we're able to bring early educators in our community together for four professional workshops each year, provide hands-on coaching in classrooms, and open doors to higher education opportunities that help teachers advance in their careers. Because of you, educators in Indian River County are advancing skills, and children are experiencing the lasting benefits of inspired teaching.

Why this matters:

Teachers are the backbone of early education. Research shows that well-prepared early educators can increase children's learning outcomes significantly in the first five years. By supporting the growth of local teachers, Childcare Resources helps classrooms become stronger, children gain more from their learning experiences, and families see the benefits at home. When educators are supported, the overall quality of care in the community rises, directly boosting kindergarten readiness and long-term success for children across Indian River County.

You helped children receive 2,808 hours of therapeutic services on the Childcare Resources campus.

2024-2025 Wellness & Early Intervention Impacts:

Through the Wellness and Early Intervention Program, children take part in regular developmental screenings and, when needed, receive on-site therapies such as physical, speech, occupational, and behavioral. Thanks to your generosity, these healthcare services are built into the school day, allowing concerns to be identified early, children to get the help they need to excel, and families to access resources that foster healthy growth at home and in school.

Why this matters:

When developmental concerns are addressed early, children build stronger skills and families avoid greater challenges later on. Research shows that children who receive early intervention services are more likely to succeed academically. Yet in Florida, over 66% of children under age three receive no developmental screenings, leaving many delays unidentified at a critical stage. By embedding screenings and therapies within the educational setting, we mitigate barriers to healthcare access and ensure children don't miss this critical window for support.

Because of your support, hardworking families were able to enroll at Childcare Resources, where their children thrived in an accredited, high-quality early learning environment. Classrooms follow intentional, age-appropriate curricula building knowledge and skills that prepare children for kindergarten and beyond. What takes place inside our school is truly one-of-a-kind, and it is only possible because of you.

Why this matters:

Children who attend high-quality early learning programs enter kindergarten with stronger skills in literacy, math, and social development. This foundation reduces future achievement gaps and supports lifelong success. For working parents, reliable, affordable care offers much-needed stability. And in Indian River County, 44% of households are supporting themselves at the ALICE level (Asset-Limited, Income-Constrained, Employed), which means families desperately need access to high-quality, affordable early education like ours.
